Program Highlights

B.O.W Abuja & The Reawakening of the Saints – February 24, 2025

One of the major highlights of 2025 for Favored Generation was the successful hosting of B.O.W Abuja & The Reawakening of the Saints, a gathering that brought together worship leaders, creatives, young people, and community members from different cities and backgrounds. The event created an atmosphere of unity, reflection, and meaningful connection, with attendees participating in worship sessions, mentorship conversations, and community engagement activities. Featuring notable worship leaders and speakers, the gathering encouraged collaboration, personal growth, and a renewed sense of purpose among participants while strengthening relationships within the wider community.



B.O.W Toronto – May 17, 2025

A key highlight for Favored Generation in 2025 was successfully hosting B.O.W. Toronto, a community gathering that brought together music leaders, creatives, young people, volunteers, and attendees from different cities and backgrounds. The event provided a welcoming space for music, reflection, encouragement, mentorship conversations, and meaningful community connection. Participants were able to engage, build relationships, and experience a stronger sense of purpose and belonging. B.O.W. Toronto was also strengthened through valuable community partnerships, including support from Chick-fil-A, JD Best, and The Joy Center. These partnerships helped improve the event experience, support hospitality and coordination, and demonstrate the value of collaboration in serving the community. The gathering expanded Favored Generation's local presence, strengthened relationships among community members, artists, leaders, partners, and volunteers, and laid the groundwork for future youth, outreach, and community impact initiatives.



Youth Impact Program – 2025

Through the Favored Generation Youth Impact Laptop Program, we provided 7 laptops to students and other young individuals in need in 2025. This initiative was designed to support education, digital access, skill development, and personal growth by equipping recipients with the tools needed to succeed academically and professionally. The program reflects our ongoing commitment to empowering young people with practical resources and opportunities that create long-term impact within their communities.



Thrive Community Hub – 2025 Impact Highlights

In 2025, the Favored Generation continued to serve as a growing center for community support, youth engagement, and personal development initiatives. Through programs focused on mentorship, wellness, outreach, and practical support, the Hub reached over 450 individuals and families across the USA and Nigeria.

Key highlights from the year include:

- Distribution of over 200 Hope Boxes/Gift Bags containing food supplies, hygiene products, and essential care items to families experiencing hardship.
- Hosted over 20 virtual youth and young adult renewal gatherings focused on community connection, personal reflection, leadership development, and peer encouragement through group sharing and collaborative planning.
- Engagement of more than 180 volunteers who contributed over 2,500 combined service hours across outreach programs and events.
- Support for 25 students and young creatives through mentorship, leadership coaching, and educational resource initiatives.
- Organization of three community outreach events and worship gatherings that fostered connection, collaboration, and emotional support within local communities.
- Expansion of international outreach efforts through partnerships with local organizations and volunteers serving underserved communities.

These initiatives reflect Favored Generation's ongoing commitment to creating sustainable, people-centered programs that strengthen communities, empower young people, and provide meaningful support where it is needed most.

Nature of business/accounting framework used.

1. Date and place of incorporation, commencement of operations.

Favored Generation was originally formed in USA and later started as a non-for-profit organization in Canada on January 5th, 2024. It was subsequently incorporated on May 6th, 2024, and as a Canadian Charitable organization on September 11th, 2024.

It is committed to empower youth, strengthen families, and serve communities through faith, compassion, and action. We believe every individual has God-given value and purpose. Through worship, mentorship, education, and outreach, we create spaces where people are accepted, encouraged, and equipped to thrive.

Favored Generation also has a global outreach where it focuses on community outreach, worship gatherings, youth engagement, and preparation for expanded impact programs to support students, families, and underserved communities through wellness, education, and practical care.

It is a charitable organization and is exempt from income tax.

2. Consistent Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations

The accounting policies of the organization are in accordance with Canadian accounting standards for not-for-profit organizations (ASNPO).

3. Revenue recognition

Donations and contribution receipts are recognized as they are received. In-kind donations are evaluated on FMV with proper supporting documentation.
